BOOM LIFT OPERATOR QUALIFICATION

AUDIENCE	Personnel who operate or may be assigned to operate boom-supported mobile elevating work platforms.
COURSE FOCUS	Equipment fundamentals, work-zone hazards, inspection, controls, stability, fall protection considerations, safe operation, shutdown, and practical evaluation.
DURATION	Approximately 4–6 hours, depending on experience and class size.
CLIENT PROVIDES	Serviceable boom lift, suitable evaluation area, manufacturer information, required PPE, and employer-provided site controls.
DOCUMENTATION	Roster, knowledge-check results, practical evaluation records, and completion documentation appropriate to the confirmed scope.
